



Tour Package Information

The Lattin Family has been farming the Lahontan Valley for five generations. Since 1977, the family has pioneered the production of red raspberries in Nevada. Along with generations of farmers, there have also been 5 generations of teachers. Currently, there are three Nevada certified teachers and two certified substitutes in the family collaborating to make each child's trip to the farm educational and best of all, fun.

Why Take a Farm Tour?

As times have changed, children are not exposed to farming and agriculture as often. The closest contact to farm is the produce section at the local store. On a farm tour, students have an opportunity to take a hands-on approach to learning agricultural basics. All tours are adapted to the students' age group and ability.

Educational tours give students the opportunity to learn how things grow and the working of a farm. This includes appropriate lessons on pollination, plant harvesting and uses, plant and animal characteristics, and measuring methods. Features of the tours include:

- Pick a variety of produce from Pick Your Own Gardens (raspberries, grapes, tomatoes, flowers in season). Or, take a tractor-drawn hayride to the Pumpkin Patch! Pick your perfect pumpkin from our big patch.
- Visit the animals in Critterville. See the goats on the goat walk as well as chickens and other fowl.
- Students will learn where food comes from in one of our interactive class units.
- Younger students will also enjoy a ride on our cow train.

What Students Take Home

Our fun educational tours give kids the opportunity to learn about how things grow and the working of a farm. This includes:

- Lessons on pollination
- Knowledge about characteristics of animals and plants
- Harvesting the and uses of plants
- Real farm experience

Tour Dates

Tour Packages

- **Self –Guided Tour** (hayride/pumpkin or seasonal pick-your-own produce) about 20 minutes for hayride
- **Guided Education Tour** (hayride/pumpkin, cow train, educational class, and animals) 1 hour 15 minutes
- **Maze Only** (admission to this year's corn maze and a worksheet to fill out) 45-60 minutes
- **Maze Plus** (Maze admission, hayride/pumpkin) 1 hour
- **Fun Combo Pack** (Maze admission, guided education tour) 2 hours

Tour Type

The tour has four rotations. Each rotation can handle no more than 25 kids. When making arrangements with other schools/teachers, please keep that in mind. The self-guided tour is about 20 minutes for hayride, the guided tour takes about 1 hour 15 minutes and the maze takes about 45 minutes. Please be on time to ensure that you will have the full farm experience. A Minimum of 15 per group.
