Tour Package Information 2019

The Lattin Family has been farming the Lahontan Valley for five generations. Along with generations of farmers, there have also been 5 generations of teachers. Currently, there are 3 Nevada certified teachers and 2 certified substitutes in the family collaborating to make each child's trip to the farm educational and best of all, fun.

Why Take a Farm Tour?

As times have changed, children are not exposed to farming and agriculture as often. The closest contact to farm is the produce section at the local store. On a farm tour, students have an opportunity to take a hands-on approach to learning agricultural basics. All tours are adapted to the students' age group and ability.

Educational tours give students the opportunity to learn how things grow and the working of a farm. This includes appropriate lessons on pollination, plant harvesting and uses, plant and animal characteristics, and measuring methods. Features of the tours include:

- Take a tractor-drawn hayride to the Pumpkin Patch! Pick your perfect pumpkin from our big patch. Or, you can pick from a variety of produce from Pick Your Own Gardens (raspberries, grapes, tomatoes, flowers in season).
- Students will learn where food comes from in one of our interactive class units.
- Visit the animals in Critterville. See the goats on the goat walk as well as chickens and other fowl.
- Younger students can also enjoy a ride on our cow train.

What Students Take Home

Our fun educational tours give kids the opportunity to learn about how things grow and the working of a farm. This includes:

- Lessons on pollination
- Knowledge about characteristics of animals and plants
- Harvesting and uses of plants
- Real farm experience

Tour Dates

Education tours typically run from August to October, but are available anytime by appointment. We do require a reservation first. You can visit our website www.lattinfarms.com and fill out the registration form or call us at 775-867-3750.

Tour Packages

- **Self-Guided Tour:** (hayride/pumpkin or seasonal pick-your-own produce) 30 minutes
- **Add on package:** Add educational class and/or cow train/animals to self-guided tour. 30 minutes each
- **Pumpkin Plus Tour:** (hayride/pumpkin, educational class, and animals/cow train) 1 hour 30 minutes
- **Maze Only:** (admission to this year's corn maze and a worksheet to fill out) 60 minutes
- **Maze Plus:** (Maze admission, and pumpkin plus tour) 2 hour 30 minutes

Tour Type

To schedule a tour, we need a minimum of 10 paying participants. The tour has the option of **three** rotations. **Each rotation can handle no more than 35 people.** The hayride/pumpkin, educational class, and animals/cow train take about 30 minutes each (a total of 1 1/2 hours for all 3). The maze takes about 60 minutes. Please be on time to ensure that you will have the full farm experience. (*Animals and cow train when combined occur in one half hour rotation. You are not required to participate in both.)
